ORDER

On Monday, March 11, 2019, the Arizona Water Quality Appeals Board (“Board”) met to consider the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (“ADEQ”)’s Notice of New Source Analysis Pursuant to 40 CFR 122.29(b) As Ordered, filed February 15, 2019. Counsel for all parties attended.

On Friday, March 8, 2019, the Coalition Appellants filed a Motion to Review and Reconsider the Board’s November 19, Order, and Response to ADEQ’s Notice to the Water Quality Appeals Board of ADEQ’s New Source Analysis (“Motion to Review”).

After discussion with and agreement of all parties, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED adopting the following briefing schedule:


1. On or before March 25, 2019, ADEQ and Resolution Copper may file a response to the Coalition Appellants’ Motion to Review.
2. On or before April 1, 2019, the Coalition Appellants and the San Carlos Apache Tribe may file a reply.

3. The Board will schedule a meeting no earlier than April 8, 2019 to consider these matters. No further briefing will be permitted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall provide electronic copies of their pleadings to all other parties, the Board, and its counsel on the same date they are filed with the Board's Clerk.
