**JEFFERSON DOWNTOWN STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS**  
**PRE-CONSTRUCTION NEWSLETTER**

**CONSTRUCTION GETS UNDERWAY**

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department awarded a contract to Hunter Contracting Company to construct new storm drain laterals varying in diameter and new inlets to collect and convey runoff from adjacent project areas. Additional work will include removal and replacement of manholes, catch basins, concrete pavement, sidewalks, driveways, valley gutter and curbs. Storm sewer lateral connections and water services will also be installed. Removal of trolley tracks and trees will be removed in selected areas. Asphalt concrete pavement replacement will be applied at selected locations.

The goal of this project is to improve the downtown drainage network and ultimately raise the level of protection to a 10-year storm event in the downtown area.

**PROJECT LOCATIONS AND CONSTRUCTION HOURS**

The project is located in three areas:

- Adams Street: from 19<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> avenues
- Washington Street: from 15<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> avenues
- Jefferson Street: from 19<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> avenues

The project is scheduled to begin on Nov. 19, 2010 and is estimated to be complete by Jan. 31, 2011.

Construction will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays and weekends. Night construction will take place from 6 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**SAFETY FIRST**

Please obey the traffic signs and flagmen when driving through the area and allow extra time for travel to accommodate traffic delays. Please do not move any barricades. Barricades are placed for your safety and the safety of others. Thank you for your cooperation.

**TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS**

During construction, lane restrictions and delays or temporary road closures are anticipated. Traffic may be restricted to only one lane with flaggers. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

**PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

No on-street parking will be allowed while construction work is taking place. Access will be maintained to private and business driveways.

**WATER SERVICE PLANS**

In order to complete the water services and storm drain, water service may need to be shut off temporarily. The contractor will notify you in advance when a shutdown is scheduled to occur.
